



The work begins with chain foundation of 15 ch (13 + 2 turning ch).

1 round: 1 dc/sc in 3rd ch from hook, 4 dc/sc in next 4 ch, 2 dc/sc decrease (work 3 incomplete dc/sc, then draw the yarn through all loops), 4 dc/sc in next 4 ch, 3 dc/sc in last ch, work on opposite side, 4 dc/sc in next 4 ch, 2 dc/sc decrease, 5 dc/sc in next 5 ch, sl.st in 2nd turning ch.

2 round: 2 turning ch, 1 dc/sc in 2dn turning ch of previous round, 4 dc/sc in next 4 stitches, 2 dc/sc decrease, 4 dc/sc in next 4 stitches, 3dc/sc in the same stitch, 4 dc/sc in next 4 stitches, 2 dc/sc decrease, 4 dc/sc in next 4 stitches, 1dc/sc in 2dn turning ch of previous round and sl.st in turning ch.

3 round: 2 turning ch, 4 dc/sc in next 4 stitches, 2 dc/sc decrease, 9 dc/sc in next 9 stitches, 2 dc/sc decrease, 4 dc/sc in next 4 stitches and sl.st in turning ch.

4 round: 2 turning ch, 3 dc/sc in next 3 stitches, 2 dc/sc decrease, 7 dc/sc in next 7 stitches, 2 dc/sc decrease, 3 dc/sc in next 3 stitches and sl.st in turning ch.

5 round: 2 turning ch, 6 dc/sc in next 6 stitches, 2 dc/sc decrease, 5 dc/sc in next 5 stitches, work 1 incomplete dc/sc, then insert hook into 2nd turning ch and next dc/sc and draw the yarn through all loops.

6 round: 2 turning ch, 4 dc/sc in next 4 stitches, 2 dc/sc decrease, 3 dc/sc in next 3 stitches, work 1 incomplete dc/sc, then insert hook into 2nd turning ch and next dc/sc and draw the yarn through all loops.

Keep with absorbent cotton and sew together the top edgings.

Work leaves and rose.

It is required about 10 cm of a green ribbon for leaves and 35 cm of a pink ribbon for a rose and 10 cm of white ribbon for grip of heart.

From a green ribbon forms leaves and sew them to heart. Then work a base for rose (see pictures): make five legs like spider radiating from center.

Couching pink ribbon.

Bring ribbon up at center and begin weaving over and under the spider legs in a circular manner. To end, insert needle beneath flower and pull through heart.

Work grip with white ribbon.





Work leaves and rose.

It is required about 10 cm of a white ribbon for leaves, 35 cm of a red ribbon for a rose and 10 cm of pink ribbon for grip of heart.

From a white ribbon forms leaves and sew them to heart. Then work a base for rose (see photo and pictures): make five evenly spaced legs radiating from center. Bring needle up at 1 and down at 2, creating a "V". Bring needle up at 3, above point of V, then stitch down at 4. Add two more legs (5-6 and 7-8) to create the base.

Couching red ribbon.

Bring ribbon up at center and begin weaving over and under the five legs in a circular manner until the desired fullness is achieved. To end, insert needle beneath flower and pull gently through heart.

Work grip with pink ribbon.
